

8. Performance indicators and measuring progress

- Implementation of the GS RSWMP must be accompanied by monitoring and reporting of progress. This is best practice and is also established as a requirement in the RWC Terms of Reference and the RSWMP itself.

Noted:

- Concerns raised over duplicate reporting and if the data is rigorous enough to tell us if we have met the aims and outcomes.
- Some proposed KPI's are being measured in ha. Will need to be cautious of this as many Council reserves etc. are not even 1ha in size. May need to change to sq m or at least align with WAP reporting.
- An additional KPI could be "No. species delimited" ie. Distribution established by determining presence and absence.
- Concerns raised by Roads and Maritime services regarding their capacity to report on KPIs due to not collecting data specifically on weed management.

Action 6: GS LLS to change proposed KPI reporting regarding ha to align with WAP reporting e.g. 'under 1ha' and 'over 1ha'.

Action 7: GS LLS to add a new proposed KPI – 'Number of species delimited'. Nominated species to be delimited:

1. Kudzu (*Pueraria lobata*)
2. Kei apple (*Dovyalis caffra*)
3. Sea Lavender (*Limonium perezii*)
