The Peri-urban network is a platform for biosecurity stakeholder engagement with a focus on small landholdings. The network is a joint initiative of the Australian Department of Agriculture, Chief Environmental Biosecurity Office and the NSW Department of Primary Industries. There are several agencies who make up the network expert group including DPI, LLS, Dep of AG and Universities each focusing on different aspects of biosecurity.
